Overview

- When an applicant applies for Nipawin Bible College as a direct result of the influence of a current/returning NBC student, the current/returning student will be eligible for a \$750 Recruitment Scholarship provided they meet the criteria listed below.

Criteria

- Scholarship funds will be applied to the second semester of your NBC studies. It is intended for those students or applicants who recruit an individual to attend NBC for an entire year (two semesters). Thus it is ideal if the individual you've recruited is at NBC during the same period (calendar year) as you. Since the scholarship will not be applied until the recruited individual is beginning their second semester, the student or applicant applying for this scholarship will not be eligible to receive it if they are only staying at NBC for one semester after applying for this scholarship, or if the recruited individual only stays one semester.
- Incoming applicants are eligible for this scholarship if they recruit another applicant
- In order to be eligible for the recruitment scholarship, the individual you have recruited to apply for NBC should not have already been in contact with one of NBC's staff recruiters. This will be at the discretion of the NBC Admissions Department.
- To maintain eligibility, the NBC student being awarded the Recruitment Scholarship must have attained a minimum 2.0 GPA throughout the first semester of their current year of studies at NBC.
- There is no deadline to apply for this scholarship, however you must still meet the above criteria with regards to when you and the individual you recruit are at NBC.
