



# NBC Welcomes New President: JOHN LOGE

John and Audrey are responding with joy and expectation to a clear call from God to serve NBC as its next president. John currently fills several roles as a medical doctor in High Prairie, AB (in the emergency room and as a physician leader). Both John & Audrey see how God has prepared John to begin this ministry and they are in the process of selling their current home and land and purchasing a new home and land. Audrey's passion is to support him in ministry (which she does admirably) and take care of her herd of handmilked dairy cattle. Fresh milk, cheese, cottage cheese, kefir, and butter are frequently on the menu at the Loge household!

He believes that there are three essential components to Biblical education: first, it starts in the family; second, the church provides Biblical training in several venues (worship services, Sunday school, youth groups, and kids' clubs); thirdly, Bible colleges. This means that the Bible college needs to have excellent teachers and mentors so the pastors that do the training in the churches can feed the flock well. The flock IS the family that goes home and provides the daily teaching and mentoring in a Christian home. So all three need to be working well in order to prepare the next generation of Christian leaders, moms, dads, and camp counselors. This is why all education, John believes, needs to be focused on knowledge that is applicable in the real world of ministry, service, the workplace, and the family.



John looks forward to working with the NBC team this fall. One of his tasks for the coming year will be a search for professors and an academic dean. He is passionate about communicating to young people the riches of the Bible, how to study it, and how to apply it. He believes wholeheartedly that higher Biblical education needs to be practical and desires to pass on to staff and students what he has been given, both in life experience and academics. He will be teaching a one week modular course November 25-29 on sexual ethics, which he invites all young people and ministry staff to participate in, at no charge to audit the course.

#### DISCIPLESHIP & STUDENT LIFE
