PROGRAMS

FOUNDATIONS FOR LIFE

T YEAR PROGRAM

Establish and strengthen a foundation for Christian living by being discipled and growing in your knowledge, character, and relationship with God. The Foundations for Life program is designed as a foundational discipleship year, which will equip the student with a solid biblical basis from which to pursue a career, vocational training, or university studies. The focus is on personal Christian growth, a foundational understanding of the Bible, and life application.

Deacon's Track

The Foundations for Life Deacon's Track is designed for those who might wrestle with meeting academic requirements in the original Foundations for Life program. These students take the same classes, but receive different syllabi. With tempered academic expectations and homework, Deacon's Track students are then placed into local vocational settings for 10 hours a week to grow in practical life skills.

CHRISTIAN MINISTRY DIPLOMA

Develop a maturing Christian character and passionate commitment to servant leadership in your church, workplace, and community. Upon completion of the two year program requirements, students will receive a Christian Ministry Diploma. This program is designed for those who anticipate ministry in their local church or simply want a solid base for further vocational training. The focus is on knowledge of the Scriptures, appreciation for the local church, and skill development for church ministry.

Note: *The Christian Ministry Diploma is also available as a part of the Deacon's Track NBC cultivates scriptural **conviction** and **competence** through practical, relevant teaching. Our programs are designed to root beliefs and convictions in the Scriptures, with breadth of understanding and sound interpretation. Our instructors teach for change, addressing practical and current life issues. NBC believes this is key to applying Scripture to life and reaching others with the truth of God's Word.

BACHELOR OF CHRISTIAN MINISTRY

Z YEAR PROGRAM Apply what you are learning as you begin to take on greater responsibility and leadership at the college, local churches, and other ministries. The Bachelor of Christian Ministry program offers an increasing degree of knowledge and leadership development as it builds onto the Christian Ministry Diploma courses (years 1 and 2). The program objectives are: a competent knowledge of Scripture, an attitude of servant leadership, and skill development for Christian ministry.

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN BIBLICAL STUDIES

∓ YEAR PROGRAM **Lead** others as you serve in a 12 credit-hour internship focused on forming godly character, growing in practical knowledge, and gaining ministry skills. This program is designed for those anticipating involvement in ministry, whether full-time or lay ministry, and in leadership roles. The student will be further equipped to understand and communicate God's Word, counsel and nurture others, and provide Christ-like leadership. This program will equip the student with sound Bible knowledge and provide a base for those wishing to pursue further studies.


DISCIPLESHIP & **DEVELOPMENT**

INTENTIONAL DISCIPLESHIP

Discipleship is integral to NBC. It happens through teaching and relationships: in the classrooms, the dorms, the soccer field, the dining hall, etc. Our 7-24 small groups meet weekly with the purpose of moving every student from disciple to disciple-maker.

CHURCH INVOLVEMENT

NBC is committed to cooperating and integrating with the ministry of the local church. This connection to a local church is vital, especially as we seek to send out students better equipped to love and serve in their own local churches. Therefore, all staff and students are expected to attend a local church while at NBC. Students have the opportunity to apply what they are learning as they participate in fellowship and service.

DAILY CHAPELS

Chapels facilitate worship through music, prayer, Scripture reading, and challenges from various guest and in-house speakers.

HOME GROUPS

These groups meet in staff homes throughout the year to cultivate community outside the classroom.

ROYALS wRECk

NIPAWIN INDOOR SOCCER LEAGUE (NISL)


The co-ed community league has been based at NBC since 1992 and is hosted in NBC's own Rempel Auditorium. It provides competitive soccer from October through March each year.

FRESHMEN MINISTRY PRACTICUM (FMP)

Freshmen students are divided into teams and sent throughout the province on a week-long missions trip to serve in various ministries and camps. Under the leadership of NBC staff and veteran ministry/missionary leaders, they learn about ministry, teamwork, and the needs within the communities they serve.

OUTREACH MINISTRY PRACTICUM (OMP)

This week-long missions trip is structured and led in the same way as FMP. However, it is designed for second year students, with the intent of exposing them to a broad range of ministry opportunities and needs in Canadian urban, and cross-cultural settings.



STUDENT MINISTRIES

Each week, students engage in ministry contexts in Nipawin and area: youth ministry, children's ministry, senior's visitation, First Nations outreach, music, drama, and more. This opportunity to apply classroom learning to world realities is vital for developing servant leaders.

MISSION PARTNERSHIP

One of Nipawin's core values, is strategic partnership. We believe all students should be part of the great commission through going or sending. NBC has a full-time Ethnos Canada rep on staff, who oversees the annual NBC Missions Conference. Students have opportunity to meet missions reps personally, hear about gospel needs all around the world, and put themselves in a position to discern God's missional direction in their lives moving forward.


FACEDOWN

CHAPEL TEAMS

Situated about 140 kilometres east of Prince Albert, and 300 kilometres northeast of Saskatoon, our campus is equipped with dorms, a full service dining hall, gymnasium, sports field, library, student lounge, and academic building. Facilities are within walking distance of beautiful hiking trails along the river.

We believe in environmental and financial stewardship and receive power from over 7000 feet of solar panels - one of the largest solar arrays in western Canada.


CAMPUS DAYS

FINANCES

NBC partners with camps to offer matching scholarships to students who work full-time at a camp during the summer. Students may receive up to \$1500 per year.


MINISTRY CHILDREN SCHOLARSHIP

HOME BASED EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP


In recognition of the sacrifice and time investment made by these parents, NBC offers successful Home Based Education applicants up to \$1000 towards their 1st year at Nipawin.
