

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This class is an introduction to reading and interpreting the *Koine* Greek of the New Testament as a foundation for Bible study and exegesis. God's Word remains the same. The problem is that the languages into which the Bible is translated are living languages where word meanings are not static.

The return to Hebrew and Greek study was one of the primary fuels for the Reformation. There will always remain a need for the study of Greek as we continually seek to go "Ad Fontes (to the sources)" to avoid misinterpreting God's Word and to correct those who twist it for their own purposes.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- 1. Treasure the Word of God in the Greek New Testament as they labor to understand it.
- 2. Identify select elements of Greek grammar and syntax.
- 3. Reproduce the Greek verb system.

- 4. Translate 320 common Greek words (words occurring 50x or more in the NT), 82.55% of the Greek New Testament!!!
- 5. Sightread passages of the New Testament that contain only words occurring fifty times or more.

COURSE ASSIGNMENTS

Workbook Assignments – 25%

• The student will complete their workbook assignments and be prepared to go through them in the class following the one in which the grammar was covered (e.g. workbook assignment from chapter 22 will be discussed in the same class period as the grammar for chapter 23).

Quizzes – 35%

- There will be a quiz for most of the chapters covered in class (see schedule for specifics). The quizzes will cover the grammar and vocabulary for each chapter. They will take place at the beginning of the class period following the one where the grammar was covered.
- Vocabulary and grammar review is **required daily**. Students should plan to devote an hour every day to the study of Greek whether an assignment is due or not (this will make the quizzes and exams a breeze!).
